- Those members that are elected will serve a **2-year** term beginning July 1, 2007.

Elections for new members of the council will be held:

- **Tuesday, March 6 through Friday, March 9** at Timberline in the Main Office.
- Friday, March 9 and Saturday March 10 at Timberline before the school Grand Concert.

Only parents or guardians of students who will be attending Timberline next year and live in areas 1, 3, 4 and 6 may vote. A simple majority of those parents or guardians voting for each area will determine the election. Results of the election will be made available to the public upon request.
