Before a student is enrolled in a Utah public school, the student's parent(s) or legal guardian(s) must show proof of Utah residency in the school district in which the student desires to enroll. (UC.A. 53A-2-201)

Below are examples of documentation a school may request to show residency:

necessary to satisfy residency requirements for public school enrollment. It is not necessary for school personnel to retain documentation provided by a student's parent(s) or legal guardian(s) once residency has been confirmed.

The following do not establish residency:

- · Powers of attorney
- · Letters from friends or relatives

- Property owned in Utah school district boundaries
- · P.O. box in school district boundaries
