TEAL Time at Vista Heights Middle School

TEAL Time is a 30-minute segment of the school day schedule when students have the opportunity to meet with their teachers to re-learn (remediate) essential concepts if they are struggling. Students will use their planner daily to track assignments and homework. Teachers will use the planner to STAMP if a student needs to meet with them during TEAL Time.

If a student does not receive a stamp, they will remain with their A2 or B6 teacher for *Homeroom*, and read a book or work on homework.

Students may seek out a stamp from a teacher if they feel they just need more help.

On Fridays, we will offer Enrichment and Activities for students for additional learning, and as motivation. Schedules for these will be posted in the hallway at school and announced during the week. Students may choose to attend if they have no stamps on Friday.

Students are expected to use their TEAL Time appropriately and effectively. Students who choose not to do this are subject to consequences related to tardiness, truancy, and misbehavior.

We encourage parents to check their student's planner, and Skyward regularly. Because students are required to carry their planners at all times, and due to their integral nature in our school programs, they will be charged a \$5 replacement fee if lost.

TEAL Time runs from 11:00-11:35 a.m. Tues-Friday.
