Utah Immunization Requirements 7th Grade Entry 2017-2018

To attend the 7th grade a student must have proof of receiving the following immunizations. **Avoid the last minute rush – Get your shots done and turned in to the school now!**

You will not be able to start the 7th grade without the school having the following documentation on file:

- 1 Tetanus/Diphtheria/Pertussis (TdaP) booster ***MUST CONTAIN PERTUSSIS***
 - Kindergarten DTaP does not count for this dose
 - o Tdap required regardless of interval since last dose tetanus/diphtheria containing vaccine
- 2nd Varicella (Chickenpox) vaccine or Disease Verification
- 1 Meningococcal Vaccine

This is in addition to other required immunizations that should have already been completed and on file.

If you have not yet had the above vaccinations, take this form to the doctor or clinic to be completed

In order for us to start updating our records now, please **turn in a record** as proof of the vaccinations to your child's <u>current</u> school as soon as possible. The updated record should include dates of the following vaccines:

•	2 nd Varicella vaccine

•	Meningococcal vaccine	
	8	Date stamp and Signature of Provider

*Please provide a <u>copy of the vaccine record</u> from your doctor or the clinic where the vaccination was received. MUST HAVE SIGNATURE OR STAMP OF CLINIC TO VERIFY COMPLETED.

An appropriate Utah Department of Health Exemption form must be completed <u>for those children who claim exemption</u> to immunizations for religious or personal reasons. These must be signed at Utah County Health Department. NOTICE: Utah County Health Department charges a fee for this service. If your student is unable to have immunizations due to a medical condition, then your child's physician can obtain and sign a Utah State Authorized Medical Exemption form at his/her office.

Only Utah State Authorized Medical Exemption forms can be accepted.
