Suggestions and Recommendations for Parents/Guardians

• Elementary students will be instructed by a certified teacher from the student's school.
• As your child is being taught at home, a quiet, well-lit, school-like working situation is recommended.
• The working area provided in the home for student instruction should be quiet, academically focused, and free from all interruptions such as telephone calls, etc.
• Distracting noises, such as music, television, children playing, etc., should be carefully controlled.
• The parent, or adult designated by the parent, will need to be present in the home during the period of instruction by the teacher and remain in the home during the lesson. It is requested that parents refrain from being in the room when instruction is taking place, except at the request of the teacher.
 Parents along with the student should properly care for district owned books and supplies left in the home. In the case of damage or loss of books and supplies, the parent is held responsible.
• In the event any family member has a contagious illness, the home/hospital teacher should be notified in advance of the scheduled appointment so as not to compromise the health of the teacher
• The Home and Hospital teacher is to be notified 24 hours in advance if the student is unable to receive instruction. The teacher will notify parents/student 24 hours in advance if they are unable to meet with the student.
• Two missed appointments, without notice, will result in cancellation of services. Parents would then be required to pick-up and deliver homework to and from the school. Credit is based on the completion of assignments and attendance. No student may earn more than a total of 2.0 credits per quarter.
