


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STAKEHOLDER REPORT

Flight Time

Last year, we implemented a new academic intervention to help students with their academic work. *Flight Time* is a 35 minute block of time after second period when students can work on school assignments, get help from teachers, make-up missed work, or study. The major difference from our prior intervention time is that students are assigned to a location each day, instead of choosing a room based on their grades. This change allows us to locate students in the building and ensure they are in the correct place. Additionally, this time is regularly used to reward students who are caught up on all their work.

Vista Values: Respect & Responsibility

In 2015, we implemented our Vista Values of Respect and Responsibility. We created a rubric which discusses what these look like in various areas of our school. For example, in the lunchroom responsibility includes cleaning up and waiting in line. In the classroom, respect means listening while others talk. We are intentional in teaching these behaviors during classes, assemblies, and occasionally during Flight Time.

This year, we are rewarding students who exhibit these character traits with 5 Star points. 5 Star points can be redeemed for a variety of prizes every Friday in our Hawk Shop. So far, students have earned almost 80,000 5 Star points! This shows that students are regularly demonstrating and being recognized for doing the right thing. Way to go, Blackhawks!

TRUST LANDS REPORT 2017-18 GOALS

Goal # 1: Students will increase SAGE scores by 3% in all tested areas.

Language Arts—44% to 45% (1% increase)

Math-62% to 57% (5% decrease)

Science—65% to 58% (7% decrease)

Goal #2: 95% of students will pass all classes with 95% of 9th graders on track for high school graduation:

9th grade—86% on track for graduation,

8th grade—83% passed all classes

7th grade—89% passed all classes.

Goal #3: Students will improve writing and language scores on SAGE by a z-score increase of .25 or higher.

9th grade— +.144 in writing , and +.23 in language skills.

8th grade— -.42 in writing, and +.22 in language skills.
