Lunch Information

The National School Lunch Program waiver that has been providing FREE meals to students has expired for all Alpine School District Schools. Households must apply every year to confirm eligibility for free and reduced meals. You will need to fill out a free and reduced meal application to see if you qualify for free and reduced meals for the 2022-2023 school year. The Open House will give students and parents an earlier opportunity to visit the school, talk to teachers, pay their school fees, and get comfortable with the school.

STATE IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS FOR 7TH GRADE ENTRY 2022-2023:

Each 7th grade student must provide proof of a Tdap Booster (Tetanus/Diphtheria/Pertussis), 2nd Varicella (chickenpox), 1 Meningococcal in addition to their other immunizations which should have already been completed (*i.e. MMR, Polio, Dtap/DPT, Hepatitis B, Hepatitis A, Varicella (Chickenpox)*).

*If you have signed an exemption in the past for your student, you will be required to update their exemption by taking the free on-line class (*see information below*).

To claim a **personal, religious** or medical exemption, the legal guardian must complete an on-line educational module (*free of charge*) and provide a copy of the completed form to the school official. The on-line course can be found at www.immunize-utah.org. Completion of the on-line educational module can be done at the Health Department if you do not have access to a computer. **For a medical exemption**, a written note from a licensed health care provider must be provided along with a copy of the completed on-line educational module. It should state the physical condition of the student, and why that vaccine would endanger the student's life or health.

Students claiming immunity against a disease for which immunization is required because the student previously contracted the disease must submit a document signed by a healthcare provider to the school as proof of immunity.

7th grade students must be current on immunization requirements in order to attend school.

Please find a teacher or an administrator if you need assistance or have any questions while at school the first few days. We will be in the hallways ready to help you.
