Lakeridge chose to "Stand against Pornography and Cyber Bullying"! We had activities during lunchtime and flex which brought to light our objective of Taking a Stand. Jenny Decker spoke to the student body about the harmful effects of being bullied as well as those who knew about others being bullied and doing nothing to stop it. Our grand finale was "Fight The New Drug", which educated the students about the harmful effects of pornography, that it is even worse than drugs and is harder for addicts to let go. The presenter pointed out what happens chemically in your brain when viewing pornography. He stressed don't start, but if you have, get help now before it ruins your life.
