School Community Council creates a program to use its allocation to implement a component of the school's improvement plan including:

- The school's identified most critical academic needs;
- A recommended course of action to meet the identified academic needs;
- A specific listing of any programs, practices, materials, or equipment which the school will need to implement a component of its school improvement plan to have a direct impact on the instruction of students and result in measurable increased student performance; and
- How the school intends to spend its allocation of funds under this section to enhance or improve academic excellence at the school.

Parents, teachers, and the principal, in collaboration with an approving entity, shall use School Land Trust Program funds in data-driven and evidence-based ways to improve educational outcomes.

Lakeridge began the 2017-2018 school year with \$113,220.00 in our School Trust Land Fund. This money is used to address each of the school's department's highest academic needs. All money spent is approved and voted on by the School Community Council.
