Scholarship Options

Centennial Scholarship

The Centennial Scholarship for early graduation program is a partial tuition scholarship which allows for high school graduation to be flexible. Students can earn up to \$1,000 college tuition payment for graduating one year early from high school.

See your high school counselor to set up a plan.

New Century Scholarship

Earn your Associate Degree by Sept 1st of the year you graduate from high school and the scholarship will pay a portion of your tuition for your Bachelor's Degree at a qualifying Utah college or university (last year it was 75% tuition). This scholarship requires a 3.0 GPA and the student to maintain a 3.0 GPA each semester.

You will need to meet with a UVU counselor early in your planning for UVU requirements. Call UVU Academic Advisement at 801-863-8425.

Regents Scholarship

The Regents Scholarship encourages Utah high school students to prepare for college academically and financially by taking a rigorous course of study and saving for college. There are three basic elements to the scholarship:

- Base award up to \$1,000
- Exemplary Academic
 Achievement Award up to 75%
 of tuition for 2 years, until
 completion of Associate or
 Bachelor degree.
- A supplemental award up to \$100 per year for students who contribute to their Utah Educational Savings Plan account between the ages of 14-17. The maximum supplemental award is \$400. See website Utahscholars.org
