Cost: Fees for the first class total \$110.00 (\$50 annual registration, \$35 annual materials fees, \$15 annual technology fee, plus \$10 for the first course) Visa, MasterCard, & Discover accepted (we cannot accept AMEX). All transactions are non-refundable.

All classes are designed to be completed in 30 days or less. An expired class may be renewed once for free. A class not completed within 60 days must be paid for again if you would like to complete it. You may earn a free course by completing your current course in thirty calendar days or less (no exceptions).

\*Courses are deemed "complete" when all work is finished and you have received a 70% or higher on the final course exam.

NOTICE: How courses fulfill graduation requirements or meet certain eligibility standards can be difficult to determine. Please consult your counselor before selecting any courses. East Shore is dedicated to providing open access to as much curriculum as possible, but you are responsible for all course selections.

### **Extended Year**

Cost: \$25 non-refundable per credit per term.
