Welcome and Approval of February Minutes: A motion was made by Mark Whitaker to approve the minutes from the February SCC meeting. The motion was seconded by Michelle Bagley; all were in favor and the motion was unanimously carried.

Introduction of New MRJH Principal, John Hanks: Mr. Hanks was welcomed. He taught math at American Fork High School. He then became a district math specialist. He has been a vice principal at Lehi High School for the past 6 years and is excited to become the new principal for MRJH beginning July 1st, 2018.

2018-19 Finalized Goals and Budget: See attachments. Heather Morgan motioned, Jose Carrillo seconded, motions approved. Notes: At this time, we don't have our projected budget for the following school year. At present, there is a \$19,000 overage, Mr. Whitaker suggested the following actions if budget needs to be reduced, reduce certified teachers \$10,000 and Equipment \$9,000. Mr. Whitaker will contact members when projected budget is released and the committee will meet again if necessary. Additional money could be added to equipment.

SCC Members Continuing Next Year: See attachment. Jaime Ward and Sherry Kramer have both expressed interest in running again. Heather Morgan, Marie Pavich, and Amber Bonner have all shared that they will not be running for re-election. Mr. Whitaker will invite other parents to join and an election will be held in the fall.

Community Comment: A parent advocated for the use of Trustland money to fund special education co-teaching support for Science. The student walkout was also discussed. With the protocols that were in place, the walkout was peaceful and respectful.

Proposed 2018-19 Trustlands Goals

- 1. Math--We want to 60% of our students to show proficiency on the state test.
- 2. English—We want 60% of our students to show proficiency on the state test.
- 3. Reading—We want to identify our stuggling 7th grade readers and ensure they are reading at grade level by the end of the year with a lexile score of 850 or higher.
- 4. General Academics—We want to Reduce the number of failing grades and increase the number of exceptional grades through continued emphasis on work completion and intervention for all levels of students. We would like fewer than 5% of our students to receive a failing grade each quarter and we would like 60% of our students to make the honor roll with a 3.7 or higher each quarter.
