

Admission Procedure

To be admitted to one of the programs at MATC a student must do the following:

- 1. Prerequisites:
 - High school students (juniors and seniors) are required to meet with, discuss, and complete their registration with their school counselor, prior to enrollment in MATC programs.
 - Adult students are required to complete a basic assessment of reading and math skills. The test is free and takes approximately 1 hr to complete. For additional information, call the Testing Center (801) 753-4110.
