Directions:

1. Sign up for one country in Sub-Saharan Africa from class list. (Only one student per country per class.)

2. On an 11x17 inch paper you should:

- a. Draw or trace the outline shape of the assigned country filling up the center of the page. Space should be left for the name of the country.
- b. Write/trace and color the name of the country in large attractive letters.
- c. Research assigned country and illustrate the 5 themes of geography. You should have at least one visual for each theme. Pictures may be drawn or traced, but cannot be "clip art" cutouts pasted on the paper or pictures downloaded from the internet.
- d. List the 5 themes on the back side of the paper and list the symbol you chose on the front next to the name of the theme. Write a small paragraph description (not just a single sentence) of the theme and how that theme is illustrated on the front. Description may be typed and pasted on the back side of the project. You need to have enough information on the back to teach the class about your country and explain what the symbols mean.
