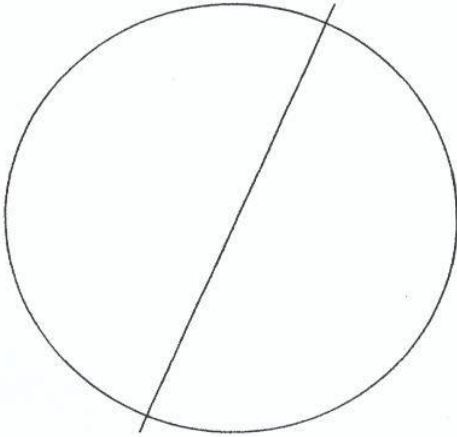


**Circle Assignment****Drawing 1**

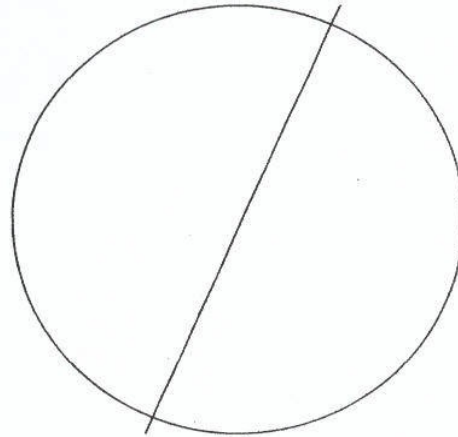
On the globe diagram below:
