

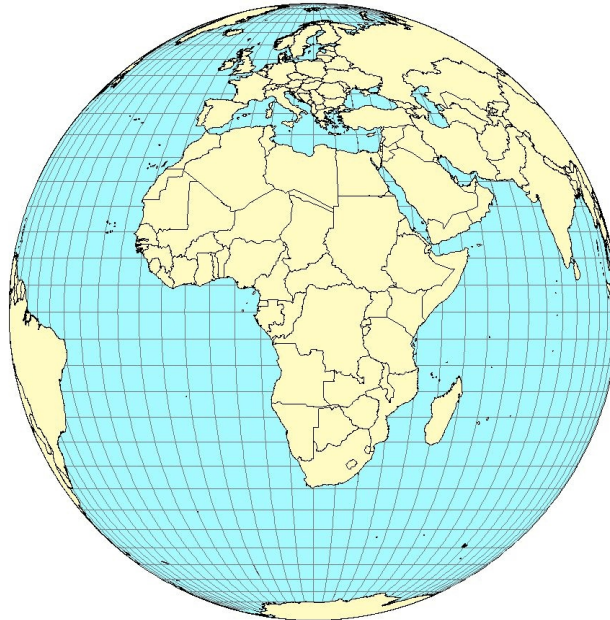
# Sub-Saharan Africa Map

Directions: Use the maps on pages 507, 509, 540, 564, & 24-25 to label and color the following.

1. Use the map on page 507 to identify which countries belong to the Sub-Saharan Africa Region. On the map below, color all the countries that are included in Sub-Saharan Africa the same color. DO NOT COLOR THE 5 COUNTRIES OF NORTH AFRICA (Including Western Sahara). Be careful to only shade the countries of Sub-Saharan Africa.



2. On the other side of these directions, carefully label and color the following. Hint: Write small as there are many things to locate in a small area:

a. Shade the ocean and seas blue. Label the following:

Atlantic Ocean, Indian Ocean, Mozambique Channel, Gulf of Guinea

b. Trace the following rivers in blue from end to end and label:

Niger River, Nile River, Congo River, Zambezi River

c. Label the following physical features (Shade lakes blue):

Lake Victoria, Lake Tanganyika, Lake Chad, Lake Nyasa, Sahara, Sahel, Kalahari Desert, Namib Desert, Cape of Good Hope, Mt. Kilimanjaro

d. Label the following cities. Make a symbol for the cities in the correct geographic location on your map and name the city: Cape Town, Johannesburg, Nairobi, Kinshasa, Dar es Salaam, Lagos
