ASD Elementary and Secondary Advanced Learning Lab (A. L. L.) Testing

The Alpine School District (ASD) Gifted Services department will be conducting 8 sessions of testing for placements for the 2013-14 school year. Any interested 2nd grader through 7th grader in ASD is invited to attend a testing session to qualify for a placement in an Advanced Learning Lab (A. L. L.). The testing will occur according to the schedule below. All 2nd graders, 4th graders and 6th graders interested in a placement for the next year **will have** to test to be placed in a program. Students may participate for a two-year period with that testing. 3rd graders, 5th graders and 7th graders may test for openings that may occur in a class.

Testing for both Elementary and Secondary Advanced Learning Lab (A. L. L.) programs will be done in January. (Please note that the name of the Secondary Labs will be A. L. L. as well starting this year to keep the name consistent.) You can check at your neighborhood school office to receive more information about the testing. The online registration will open September 19 and close 2 days before each testing session. There will be a \$20.00 fee for the testing.
