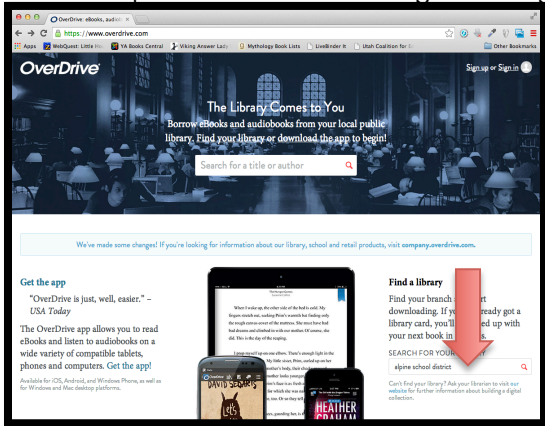


How to Check Out eBooks on Your Electronic Device

1. Go to Overdrive.com and select Alpine School District as your library.



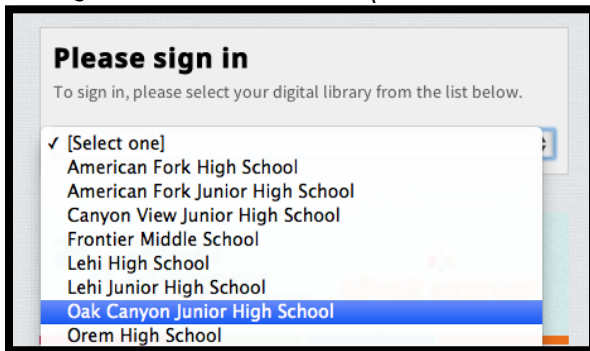
2. Go to Overdrive.com by accessing the link on the OCJH homepage.



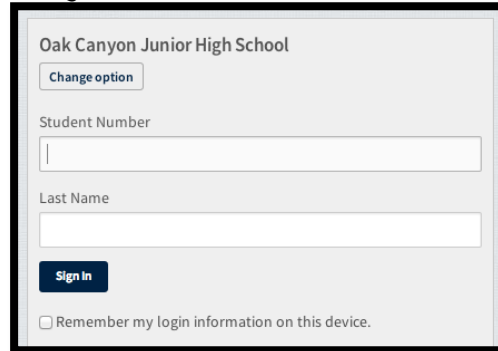
3. Browse our OJCH library catalog and click on the blue link to access digital titles at Overdrive.com.



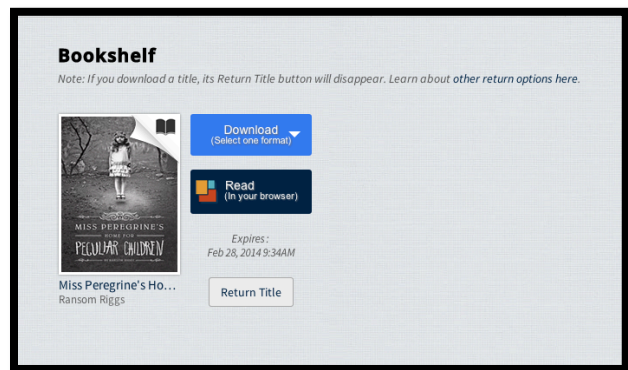
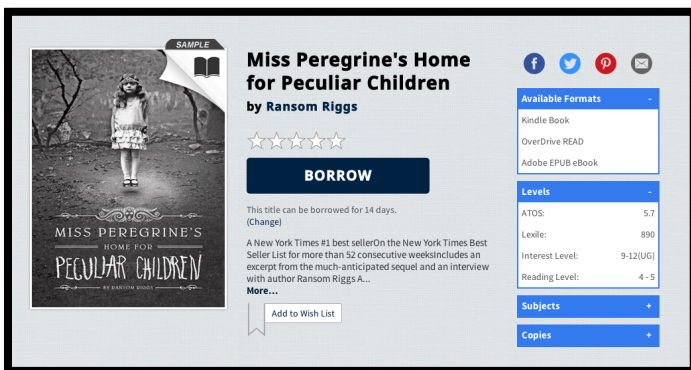
Select your school from the dropdown list.



Log with your student i.d. number and last name.



It will take you to the book record. If you choose to download the book – you pick the format that works on your device and you have it checked out for two weeks. It will expire at the end of that time and self destruct.



If you choose to read the book in your web browser you can return the title when you are finished. If you download the book make sure you have installed the Overdrive app or have a Kindle. If you click 'read in browser' it will open a short tutorial on how to use their reader, which you can go through or skip.
