#### Goal #1 Goal

Students who are identified as being below grade level in reading will increase by at least one grade level within the year.

Incoming reading levels will be measured using the Read 180 program at the beginning and end of each semester.

# **Action Plan Steps**

One section of Read 180 will be added to the schedule, and two sections of English to reduce class sizes and offer more individualized instruction.

#### Goal #2 Goal

EDIT

We will reduce the number of failing 9th graders to less than 5%. This means 95% of our 9th graders will be on track for graduation and will go to high school with seven credits. Four credits will be in the required Math, English, Science, and Social Studies.

#### **Academic Areas**

- Reading
- Mathematics
- Writing
- Science
- Social Studies

#### Measurements

We will record the number of students who are deficient credit at the end of each quarter and at the end of the school year. We will also be monitoring students with F's each week in our weekly meeting with counselors.

# **Action Plan Steps**

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We will work with at risk students individually as counselors and administrators, and will hire a student advocate to track and follow up with students.

We will pay for two periods of 9th grade Guided Studies. This class will provide additional study time and one-on-one help for students who have been identified as at risk of becoming deficient in credit.

We will be having two Digital Curriculum sections second semester. This class will provide the opportunity to recover credit for 9th graders who have already failed classes and lost credit.

As a proactive measure, we will offer 10 sections of Student Success Skills for 7th graders. This class will teach executive skills such as time management and organization, along with study strategies, test taking tips, goal setting, relationship building, etc. This is an investment in future 9th graders, hoping to prevent academic problems before they start.
