As the new school year is right around the corner, there are some items of importance we'd like to put on your radar prior to the first day of school:

• 1 to 1 Student Chromebook Deployment: This year, all Oak Canyon Students will be assigned a Chromebook for their use both at school and at home. We want to make you aware of some important information regarding the Chromebook deployment. Students will receive their device during their Student Success for 7th Graders and in their English classes for 8th and 9th graders on August 18-19.

Chromebooks will only be checked out to students who have received the proper parental permissions in Skyward. These parental permissions are part of the yearly update required for each student in Skyward. • New Pick Up and Drop Off Traffic Pattern: Due to the construction of the LDS Temple adjacent to the school, we anticipate increased traffic to compound an already congested pick up and drop off system. Please be advised that a new traffic pattern will be implemented to start the new school year. This new pattern was created by a team comprised of representatives from Lindon City, Alpine School District, and Oak Canyon. There will only be ONE entry (by the Seminary building) and ONE exit (by the marquee) from the parking lot in front of the school. The entry/exit in the center of the parking lot will be closed off indefinitely. New signage and new painting on the asphalt will identify the drive through lane as well as a pickup/drop off lane. Please refer to the map below and plan accordingly. Student safety is our top priority, and we appreciate your understanding and cooperation as we make this adjustment.
