CHROMEBOOK WELLNESS CHECK DURING HOMEROOM

The yearly chromebook wellness check will happen during homeroom May 6th - 10th. **Ideally teachers will talk to the students about it on Monday and ask them to bring their chromebooks and chargers to do the check on Tuesday.** If kids don't show their teacher the chromebook and charger by the end of the week, fines will be put on their student accounts. \$150 for a chromebook and \$30 for a charger. Fines can be removed if they bring them in late but we'd like to avoid it.

8th graders will be turning in their chromebooks and chargers on Friday, May 17th. Sticker removal stations will be set up during the week for kids to start getting them ready.

Your Students school fees/fines need to be paid by May 22, 2024 in order to receive their yearbook on yearbook day. You may check your students balance anytime by logging onto myschoolfees.com or calling the finance window at 801-610-8141. Year-end fines will be imported into student accounts on May 17, 2024. Statements will be emailed that afternoon. This will give students a chance to gather books, clear any fines with teachers or the library, and pay any other remaining fees/fines before year-end activities begin. Fees/Fines that have not been paid by the end of school will be forwarded to collections.
